TRADITIONAL Malay delicacies are ripe for feasting at the Jamuan Berbuka Puasa of Sarkies restaurant at Eastern and Oriental (E&O) Hotel in Penang.

A heartwarming bowl of Bubur Lambuk or Soto Ayam Berempah should follow.

Next, help yourselves to *Nasi* Briyani Ayam and some curries.

Awaiting inside clay pots could be Daging Rendang, Ayam Masak Merah, Kurma Kambing, Sambal Udang Petai, Ikan Masin Masak Lemak, Sotong Masak Kicap or Sayur Lodeh, to name a few.



Look out for the house specialty Nasi Lemak Cake, which reimagines the Malaysian classic as a multi-layered treat, and the Pulut Kuning dengan Serunding Ayam.

Over at the grilling stations, the chefs could be serving up succulent Ayam Tandoori, Kambing Bakar Berempah, Daging Panggang Kuah Percik, Ikan Asam Pedas or Shawarma Ayam, depending on the day.

For desserts are local sweets like Bubur Pulut Hitam, Kuih-Muih Melayu and an assortment of dates. But these are just a portion of the spread.

The buffet, served from 7pm to 10.30pm, also includes a vast spread of international treats that has long drawn crowds to the eatery, located at the hotel's Victory Annexe.

One would also find fresh sashimi, sushi, seafood on ice, cheeses, gratin oyster of the day, local noodles and soups, deep fried snacks, pastries, several flavours of ice cream and a chocolate fountain.

The feast is priced at RM143.30

for adults and RM70.95 for children aged six to 12.

Advance reservations are recommended as the place is packed on most nights.

For the 1st and 2nd days of Hari Raya (June 25 and 26), Sarkies also offers the Balik Kampung Buffet Lunch with a similar menu line up, priced at RM98.30 adults and RM49.15 kids.
