Opened in 2013, the Victory Annexe is considered the extended wing that's sprawled with studio suites and corner suites. Just as luxurious as the Heritage Wing, you'll get access to various modern conveniences such as a fully-equipped gym, high-speed Wi-Fi and the sweeping view of the Andaman sea from your window.

If you decide to choose a suite in the Heritage Wing, let it be the Premier Suites with a choice between a balcony and garden terrace. The grand thing about the Premiere Suite is the chance to wake up to the sight of the Andaman sea. After resting comfortably on the cosy bed, make your way to The Cornwallis restaurant for a hot breakfast before jumping into the Heritage Wing pool, which is only accessible by the Heritage Wing guests.
