The Roasted 1/2 Chicken, dripping with succulent juices, has similar accompaniments to the beef and will add variety to your table.

Java Tree is also one of the few, if not the only place in Penang to serve the Eton Mess, a traditional English dessert of transhoring whitmed grams and marinery.
